North Wales Teams

North Wales will take 3 male and 3 female runners in u15, u17, u19 categories. Clubs may also take additional runners.

Eligibility

Junior ages are as at 31st December 2024.

Qualification for selection to the North Wales Team for Inter County Championships:

- by birth
- or residence for 9 months in the region

An athlete can only compete in these Championships for one County in any 12-month period.

Athletes must be a member of a UKA athletics affiliated club and have a URN.

Selection Committee

Selection Criteria

To be considered for selection you must be actively competing in fell races in 2024, and the committee would like to see evidence of experience over several fell races, not just one-off performances.
